Commissioner Hasbrouck indicated that "Outdoor Lighting" is a hot topic right now, especially since there is currently a Zoning Ordinance under consideration addressing this issue. The department has received a lot of complaints recently; one of the issues is that zoning can't regulate existing structures. If a light is non-compliant with a revised ordinance, then there is nothing that can be done with a zoning ordinance. Perhaps the introduction of an Ordinance that is not Zoning would be enforceable.

Regarding Permits issued between July and Nov. 2014, the department has issued 1,649 permits for a total of \$239,724.77 in permit fees collected.
