RETAIL MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE CITY**

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Northampton, in City Council assembled, as follows:

Add the following to the Code of Ordinances as **Section** _____:

In accordance with Mass. Gen. Laws, c. 94G, § 3 (a)(2), there shall be no more than ten (10) retail marijuana establishments in the city of Northampton. This limit shall not apply to marijuana establishments other than those operated by a “marijuana retailer” as that term is defined in Mass. Gen. Laws, c. 94G, § 1.
