18.177 An Order to Increase Senior Tax Work-Off Program Maximum Abatement

Ordered, that

WHEREAS, the Legislature authorized the establishment of a program that provides for property tax liability reduction in exchange for volunteer services for persons over the age of 60;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council accepted the provisions of Mass. Gen. Laws Ch. 59, Sec. 5K on June 19, 2014 establishing a Senior Work-Off Abatement Program to allow persons over the age of 60 to volunteer to provide services to the city and in exchange for such volunteer services, the city reduced, by no more than \$1000 per year, their real property tax obligations:

WHEREAS, whereas the legislature amended Mass Gen. Laws, Ch. 59, Sec. 5K effective November 7, 2016 raising the amount of the allowable reduction of the real property tax bill;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED,

That City Council hereby accepts the provisions of Mass. Gen. Laws Ch. 59, Sec. 5K, as amended, establishing a Senior Work-Off Abatement Program to allow persons over the age of 60 to volunteer to provide services to the city, at an hourly rate consistent with the current minimum wage of the commonwealth, and in exchange for such volunteer services, the city shall reduce the real property tax obligations of such persons, not to exceed \$1,500 per year.
