WHAT IS THIS PROJECT?

As part of our collective response to the COVID-19 crises, the City of Northampton received a \$200,000 grant to expand spaces for socially-distanced walking, biking, shopping, and dining Downtown.

The project will use temporary materials such as planters, street murals by local artists, and concrete barriers to designate an expanded public realm.

WHEN WILL IT BE INSTALLED?

The project will be installed between Thursday, August 20 and Saturday, August 22 on Main Street between King/Pleasant St and New South St. [See traffic closure and parking ban details to the right.](#)

HOW LONG WILL IT LAST?

This is a temporary project meant to support our economy, health, and safety. The project will be in place through November.

SCHEDULE + TRAFFIC IMPACTS



8/20

12AM: Parking Ban goes into effect.

6AM: Main Street closed to all traffic and parking for the rest of the day.

8/21

Main Street reopened for traffic. Parking ban remains in effect until 4PM.

8/22

Painting, planting and other final work wraps up.
