Latex & water-based products such as paints, stains, & driveway sealers (labels will say "latex," "water-based" or "Clean up with soap and water.")

Aerosol cans that contain anything other than paint, pesticide or disinfectant

Empty containers from hazardous products*

Explosives & fireworks

Air fresheners/deodorizers*

Fertilizer without pesticides*

Alkaline or carbon-zinc batteries*

Glass & window cleaners* Ammunition

Asbestos Medical/infectious waste
Car waxes/polishes/cleaners* PCB's (transformers)
