American Red Cross Lifeguarding Waterfront Module

Pre-course Requirements:

- ◆ **Must** hold a current Lifeguarding certificate.

The American Red Cross Waterfront module is an additional certification for lifeguards possessing a current lifeguard certificate. The waterfront module is designed to train pool lifeguards in working non-surf beaches. You will be trained in using mask & fins*, searching shallow & deep water areas, and using a rescue board. Training will occur in both pool and waterfront. Upon successful completion of this course (including written and rescue skills testing), you will receive an American Red Cross Lifeguard Waterfront Training certificate.
