1. Public comment (15 min)

There was no public comment.

2. Workshop all testimonies collected

Commissioner Javier Luengo-Garrido said he collected testimony from two of the public hearings.

Noa Admin noted zoom didn't record one of the public hearings but mentioned transcripts might be available.

Commissioner Javier Luengo-Garrido noted he was able to find the transcript for the last public hearing.

Commissioner Javier Luengo-Garrido said he also collected the testimonies from the website, and those from Sean Donovan from the Wildflower Alliance.

Commissioner Carol Owen (she/her) talked about how to edit the testimonies for length while keeping the content of the comments. She noted there were moments when the transcript listed words as clearly wrong so she started to clean the data, by correcting the language but not changing the meaning or the sentence structure because the voice of the person needs to be there.

Commissioner Javier Luengo-Garrido said at the end of the day, all this collection of testimonies is going to be delivered to Dan and Cynthia to plug into the draft of the final report.

Commissioner Dan Cannity said he is sure he will receive some language changes, but that even if it isn't perfect, to make sure the quote resonates and is powerful. He said rather than like fixing all of them, he suggested picking the ones that are powerful.

The commissioners workshopped the collected testimonies and compiled them into a document.
