AN ORDINANCE**

**RELATIVE TO
PARKING AREAS RESERVED FOR MUNICIPAL USE**

An Ordinance of the City of Northampton, Massachusetts. Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Northampton, in City Council assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1

That the § 312-33 of the Code of Ordinances be amended as follows:

§ 312-33 Location of parking areas reserved for municipally owned or municipally operated motor vehicles; parking restrictions at certain municipal buildings.

C. Location of reserved spaces.

[Amended 3-19-1981; 1-5-1995; 11-1-2012]

1. Locations designated.

- a. The first parking space on Crafts Avenue closest to Main Street shall be reserved for the use of the Central Services Department.
- b. There shall be four spaces reserved for Building Department use located adjacent to the Municipal Building.
- c. The parking lot behind City Hall shall have seven spaces reserved for municipal use, beginning with the first space on the easterly side of the City Hall lot adjacent to the handicapped space.
- d. There shall be 10 spaces reserved for municipal use in the parking lot located adjacent to 240 Main Street (Memorial Hall).
- e. The Roundhouse Lot behind the Municipal Building shall have 10 spaces reserved for municipal use.**

- 2. The reserved spaces listed in Subsection C(1)(c)-~~and (d)~~, **(d)**, and **(e)** shall only be reserved Monday through Friday between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. During all other times, these parking spaces shall be available to the public.
