22.044 An Order to Appropriate \$3,000 in CPA Funds for Laurel Park Historic Signage

Ordered, that

WHEREAS, the Leeds Civic Association submitted a Small Grants application for Community Preservation Act funding for signage for Laurel Park Historic Signage;

WHEREAS, the project will preserve the unique history and culture of Laurel Park and the Chautauqua Movement, and its role in the development of Northampton;

WHEREAS, the project has community support, and was enthusiastically supported by the Northampton Historical Commission;

WHEREAS, on February 16, 2022, the Northampton Community Preservation Committee, voted unanimously to recommend that \$3,000 in Community Preservation Act funds be used to support this project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED,

That \$3,000 be appropriated from Community Preservation Act funding to the Laurel Park Historic Signage Project. And, that the grantee meets the conditions approved by the Community Preservation Committee, the Mayor, and City Council.

Specifically, \$3,000 is appropriated from the CPA Budgeted Reserve (account #2344930-359930).
