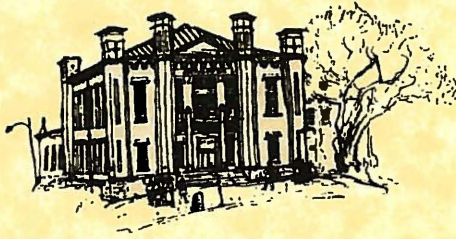


# Proclamation

- WHEREAS,** as a system for education for children from birth through the age of eighteen, the Montessori program uses materials, techniques, and observations that support the students' natural development, encourage their learning, independence, and self-confidence, and advance the principles of peace through responsible citizenship; and
- WHEREAS,** the Montessori method includes developmental teaching, one-to-one lessons, and the promotion of respect among the children and peace to humankind; and
- WHEREAS,** this year marks the 114<sup>th</sup> year of Montessori education worldwide and the 44<sup>th</sup> year of the Montessori School of Northampton,
