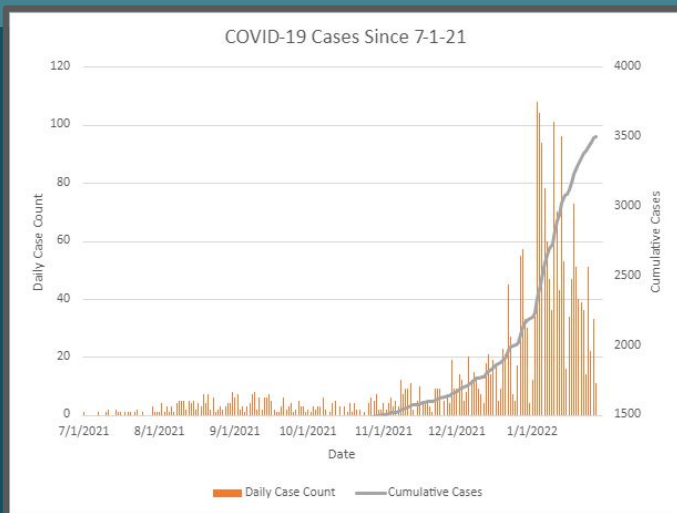

All data are extracted from MAVEN, MDPH, and vitals statistics reporting. Presented data assumes that data sources are current and accurate as of the date they are reported. Reported cases do not include self-tests performed at home or in other settings that do not have CLIA oversight.

**Active cases are cases with reported positive molecular and antigen results, who are currently in isolation under public health supervision.

****Hospitalization and mortality data is calculated based on clinical data for confirmed, laboratory molecular tested cases of COVID-19 only. It does not include data extracted from cases with antigen tests, or otherwise probable or suspect cases of COVID-19. Clinical data is drawn from MAVEN surveillance reporting, individual patient report, and vitals statistics. Data may therefore be underreported. Mortality and hospitalization data includes residents of long term care and assisted living facilities who may have had previous or permanent residence in another town/city.
