

[REDACTED] Discipline Policy

- A. **[REDACTED]** directs discipline to the goal of maximizing the growth and development of the children and for protecting the group and individuals within it.
- B. **[REDACTED]** procedures for disciplining campers are as follows:
 1. Where the staff member deems the disciplining of a camper necessary, disciplining is administered strictly verbally, and in a positive, pro-active manner. Under no circumstances shall the staff member use physical means to discipline a camper or campers
 2. Where a staff member deems it necessary to discipline an individual on a continuous basis, he/she shall inform the camp director
 3. Where the persistent disciplining of an individual – either by a staff member or the camp director – fails to remedy behavioral problems, the camp director shall inform the individual's parents
 4. Corporal punishment, including spanking, is prohibited
 5. No camper shall be subjected to cruel or severe punishment, humiliation, or verbal abuse
 6. No camper shall be denied food, water or shelter as a form of punishment
 7. No child shall be punished for soiling, wetting or not using the toilet.
 8. At **[REDACTED]** programs and explanation will be given if any child is sent home
 9. **[REDACTED]** keeps records of serious camper misbehavior, noting the date, time and the campers/staff involved.
