

Required Ratio of Counselors to Campers

Where possible each [redacted] recreation program for children has the following minimum ratio of counselors to participants:

1. Day camps have least one counselor for every ten children (1:10) 7-yrs of age or older and there is one counselor for every five campers (1:5) younger than the age of 7.
2. Staff shall be within the line of sight or close proximity to participants at all times.
3. Junior counselors may be included in meeting up to 50% of the participant to staff ratio within each group, but shall always be under the direct supervision of a coach.
4. If there is a need for additional staff to supplement the special needs of a participant, Skyhawks will provide additional staff members to accommodate mildly disabled and/or severely disabled children, if available.
5. The age of the participant is determined at the start of the camp.
