The polls will be opened at seven o'clock in the forenoon and closed at eight o'clock in the evening of the said day, and all such voters will within the said hours in the wards in which they are individually entitled to vote give in their votes for two Councilors At Large for the two ensuing municipal years, for one Councilor from each of the seven wards of the City for the two ensuing municipal years, for two members of the School Committee at Large for two years from the first Monday of January, 2024, for one School Committee Member from each of the seven wards of the City for two years from the first Monday of January, 2024, for three Superintendents of Smith's Agricultural School to serve for two years from the first Monday of January, 2024, for one Elector under the Oliver Smith Will for two years from the first Wednesday of May, 2024, for three Trustees under the Will of Charles E. Forbes for four years from the first Monday of January, 2024, and for one members of the Community Preservation Committee At Large for four years from the first Monday of January, 2024, and one member of the Community Preservation Committee At Large to begin serving upon certification of the November 7th election results and to continue serving for four years beginning the first Monday of January, 2024.

Pursuant to Mass. Gen. Laws c. 54, sec. 72, Ordered that the City Clerk shall detail no fewer than one constable for each precinct located in a polling place, no fewer than one police officer in each polling location in a school building when school is in session, and, in consultation with the Chief of Police, shall detail such other staff as may be necessary and prudent to assure a safe and orderly election in accordance with state and local laws relating to elections.
