Financial Aid Application

Income Guidelines:

Annual Gross household income must be at or below the income guidelines below.

250% of Federal Poverty Guidelines 2025

1 person \$39,125

2 people \$52,875

If your gross income is over 250 percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, you may still qualify for Financial Assistance if your out-of-pocket medical cost brings your income to or below 250 percent of the Poverty Guidelines. Medical costs include copays, prescriptions, over-the-counter medications, health insurance, medical bills, and transportation.

A copy of one of the following documents is required with your application.

- Most recent Federal tax form/first page
- SNAP acceptance letter
- Fuel Assistance acceptance letter
- Most recent 1099
- Copy of Medical costs, bills, receipts (only needed if gross income is above income guidelines)*
